Juicy, fruit-driven, ripe white - Ideal with ceasar, chicken and seafood salads, mozzarella, salmon, scallops and light creamy sauces.



Full-flavoured, nutty, oaked white - Grilled peppers, tuna, lighter Indian dishes, white meats and tomato based sauces and semi-soft cheeses.



Light, simple, delicate red - Olives, salami, tomato based pastas and light pork and turkey dishes.



Spicy, peppery, warming red - BBQ and pepper sauces, casseroles, game, lamb, duck and beef dishes and Stilton cheese.
